According to the CDC, flu season in the US is off to its earliest start in several years, and could be a bad one. The primary strain is particularly hard on the elderly. The last time a conventional flu season started this early was the winter of 2003-4, which was the most lethal in 35 years, with more than 48,000 deaths -- twice the usual number. That year's dominant viral strain was the same as this year's.

The good news is, this year's vaccine is much better matched to the dominant strain than the vaccine of 2003 was, and there's plenty of it. So if you have been meaning to get a flu shot, NOW is a very good time.

### **RECIPE CORNER**

Pumpkin Macaroni & Cheese Bonnie Gates

3 cups uncooked mostaccioli mpenne pasta
2 Tbsp. unsalted butter
2 Tbsp. flour
2 cups 2% reduced fat milk
<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup canned or fresh pumpkin puree
1 cup (4 oz) shredded Monterey Jack cheese
1 cup (4 oz) shredded Comte or Gruyere cheese
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup grated parmesan cheese
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> tsp. salt
1/8 tsp. nutmeg (optional)
1/8 tsp. black pepper

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Grease a 13x9 inch baking pan.

2. Cook pasta in salted water according to directions. Drain.

3. Melt butter in saucepan over medium heat. Whisk in flour slowly.

Whisk in milk. Cook until thick. Add pumpkin puree and mix well. Remove from heat. Add cheeses, salt, nutmeg and black pepper.

Combine sauce with pasta. Pour into pan. Bake uncovered for 25 to 30 minutes. Serves 8
