#### **Computer Clinic on Summer Hiatus**

As of June 1st no more official Computer Clinics will be held until sometime in September or October.

However, we will continue to provide free computer repair services on a "house call" basis throughout the summer. If you experience any kind of computer, tablet or cell phone problems just get in touch with Herb Van Dyke or Susan or Steve Rollison. Our phone numbers and e-mail addresses are in the Bay Lake Estates Association 2014 Resident Directory.

#### **Special Note about Viruses**

We have learned that several residents have recently paid anywhere from \$85 to \$399 to have viruses removed from their computers.

This is a service that we gladly provide Bay Lake residents free of charge. (We feel that one of the nicest things about living here is the strong sense of community—of belonging in a place where friends and neighbors can be observed helping one another every day. The computer support and services we provide are just our way of contributing to that community.)

If, for whatever reason(s) you decide to have someone else work on your computer, please be very careful about the person/company you choose to remove viruses ("malware").

If you are considering a local store-front business, at a bare minimum check their complaint record with the Better Business Bureau. If you are considering a local individual who works from his or her home, ask for several references and check them out thoroughly.

If you are considering allowing someone to remotely take control of your computer to work on it—don't do it. That would give a complete stranger total access to all the personal and financial information you have on your computer. Crimes of this nature have even been committed by convicts while they were still in prison! You just never know who you're dealing with on the other end of a phone line.

We recently cleaned up a BLE resident's computer after one of these "remote control" outfits supposedly got rid of all malware on the computer and installed software which would guarantee that no malware could infect the computer in the future. All for the "very reasonable price" of just \$299.

What we discovered was that dozens of potentially damaging programs remained on the computer, and no anti-malware software had been installed. At least, as near as we could tell, no financial information had been compromised.





#### **RECIPE CORNER**

#### CRANBERRY NUT BREAD PUDDING

With SAUCE

(From Raylene Baugh)

#### **Ingredients:**

1 Package (dozen) Hawaiian Rolls

2 Cups granulated sugar

½ cup packed light brown sugar

5 large eggs

4 cups half and half

3 tsp. pure vanilla extract

1 tsp. cinnamon

½ tsp. salt

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup (1/2 stick) butter, softened or melted

½ cup chopped pecans (more if you wish)

½ cup dried cranberries

#### **Directions:**

Preheat the oven to 350° F. Grease a 13 by 9 by 2-inch pan or use PAM spray.

Cut up rolls into pieces about 1 inch in size. Spread in pan. Sprinkle with cranberries and pecans.

Scald milk or heat till hot to the touch.

Beat eggs well.

Mix eggs together with both sugar, salt, melted butter, cinnamon and vanilla. Slowly stir in hot milk. (If you add it too fast it will coo the egg mix.) Pour over cubed bread and let sit for 10 minutes. Pat down the cranberries and pecans if sticking out too far from the milk mix so they don't brown too much.

Bake @ 350° for 55 to 60 minutes. Serve warm or cold with whipped cream or your favorite sauce.

#### Sauce:

1 cup granulated

½ cup butter

2 tsp. vanilla

1 egg beaten

¹/₄ or ¹/₂ cup of your favorite fruit juice or nectar. (I have used peach nectar or apple juice)

Mix all ingredients and heat over medium heat. Boil for one minute or till sauce thickens. Serve warm or cold.

#### **LEMON DESSERT**

Crust - 1-1/2 cups flour

1-1/2 sticks butter

2/3 c. chopped nuts

Blend with a pastry blender. Pat into a 9 x 13 pan.

Bake 300° for 30 minutes. (Will not brown.) Cool 30 minutes.

#### Filling - Blend together:

1 8 oz. Philadelphia Cream Cheese

1 T. Lemon Juice

1 cup powdered sugar

½ carton cool whip (Large).

Spread onto cool crust.

Spread 2 cans of Thank You brand Lemon Pudding over cheese mixture.

(Or make your own Lemon Pudding from box, I use 2 boxes)

Top with remaining ½ cool whip and sprinkle with chopped nuts.

Reference: Will keep for several days.

I usually double filling recipe and adjust cook whip to your desire.
