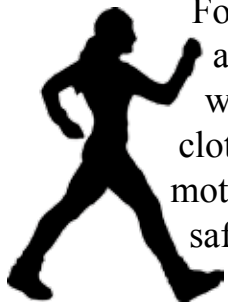

FMO FIGHTS FOR YOU

FMO stands for Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc.

For more than 50 years the FMO has worked in Tallahassee and with park Home Owners' Associations to give us all a voice. Are you facing a legal battle with your corporate owner?

Is there an internal dispute about what the HOA legally can and cannot do? The FMO can recommend a lawyer well versed in these matters. Is the legislature threatening to pass another tax on us and our neighbors? FMO will be our voice in the legislative meeting rooms.

There are about 320,000 lots in manufactured-home communities throughout Florida. Several years ago, FMO membership stood at 250,000, representing a substantial portion of these residents. Now – perhaps because there hasn't been a really big issue

lately – membership stands at only 20,000. This number may be too small for FMO to have much clout with the legislators, although their knowledge base is as strong as ever.

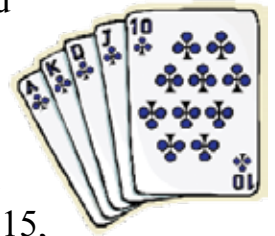

COMPUTER CLINIC

“RANSOMWARE” – THE NASTIEST MALWARE YET

You start up your computer and suddenly the screen is filled with a message, supposedly from the police or the FBI. You are notified that your computer has been used for some illegal activity—for example, pirating software or downloading child pornography—and your computer has been locked from further use. To unlock your computer you must pay a fine using a prepaid cash service. When you press keys or move or click your mouse, you discover that your computer has indeed been locked.



In a variation of this malware your message mimics the Windows Product Activation notice, telling you Windows must be reactivated due to “being a victim of fraud.” An online activation is offered, which turns out to be a long-distance call to a country with exorbitant line charges.

While some ransomware simply locks the user out of the computer, other ransomware actually encrypts critical files. In either case, paying the ransom may or may not get you an electronic “key” to unlock your computer.

What should you do?

Do NOT pay the ransom! Over \$50 million

has been extorted from ransomware victims. Instead, immediately contact Herb, Susan or Steve. We have software which may enable us to rescue your computer.

As always, prevention is a lot better and a lot easier than remediation. If you're not sure what you should be doing to prevent being infected by malware, you need to come talk with us at one of the Wednesday Computer Clinics from 1:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m.

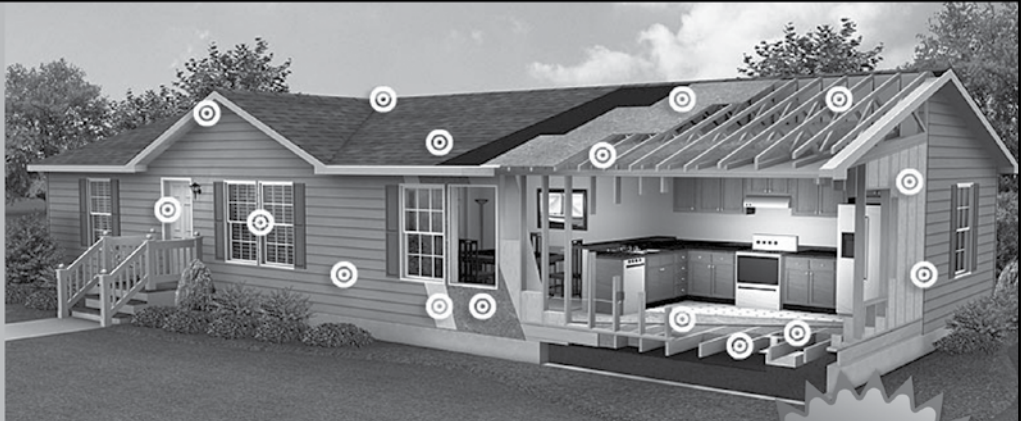

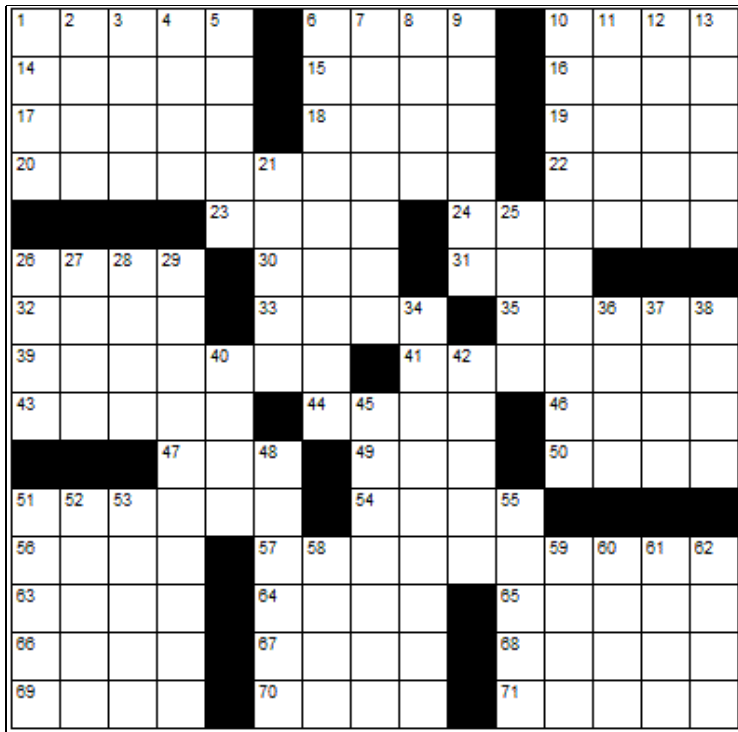

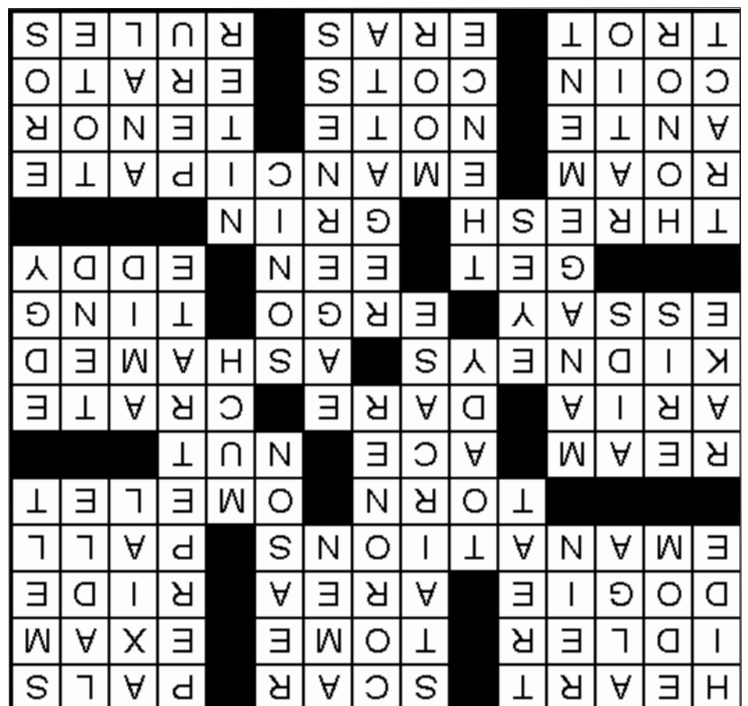
