

SO WHAT ABOUT WINDOWS 10?

Since you're reading this article, you're probably running some version of Microsoft Windows on your computer – right? That being the case, unless you've been living under a rock you have undoubtedly been hearing about the release of Windows 10.

The biggest news about Windows 10 is that Microsoft is offering a <u>free</u> upgrade to all registered users of Windows 7 and Windows 8. You have until July 28, 2016 to claim your upgrade. (Rumors have been flying that if you take the free upgrade you will have to pay some kind of annual fee at some time in the future.

Not true. The upgrade is free in all respects.)

You may be wondering if you should go ahead and download and install the upgrade **now.** In a word, our advice is: not yet.

Okay, that's two words. Let's try it in ten words, then. "Do not upgrade until you learn more about Windows 10." (You just counted to make sure that was actually ten words, didn't you?!)

Later this year—after the snowbirds' migration—we will conduct a Windows 10 workshop. You'll be able to see the main new features and learn...

- why you may not want to upgrade
- how to install the upgrade so you can get your old system back if you hate the new one
- some of the cool new features of Windows
 10 that may make you want to upgrade

If you have a computer with Windows 8 or 8.1 on it you will probably want to upgrade; especially if you miss the start menu. Windows 10 doesn't restore the start menu back to the way it was in Windows 7 but it's a lot better (in Susan's opinion) than what was available in Windows 8. Susan has been running Windows 10 for a few weeks now and likes it much better than Windows 8.
