
### DOG TRAINING

### **COMPUTER CLINIC**

### Google Fun and Useful Tricks

You can find out anything you want to know by doing a Google search. Well, almost. But you can do tons of cool things with Google, too, as evidenced by the following.

**Play "Atari Breakout."** You remember this early, early video game—right? Go to Google Images (images.google.com) and type <u>Atari Breakout</u> in the search box. Use the left and right arrow keys to move the paddle.

**Play PacMan**. Do a regular Google search for <u>Pacman</u> and click the pop-up where it says "Click to Play." Control PacMan's movements with the up, down, left and right keys. (They weren't terribly responsive on my computer, but the retro game was still fun to play.)

**Convert Currencies**. Converting back and forth between dollars and other currencies might be particularly useful if you're travelling. That's easy to do by simply running a Google search on your smart phone—and it's even easier if you use voice input. Just type (or say), for example, <u>35</u> Mexican pesos to U.S. dollars, or 100 U.S. dollars to Canadian dollars.

Convert Quantities from One Unit to Another. Another good smart phone Google search capability. Recently I needed to take a "5 milliliter" dose of cough syrup. Our neighbors to the far north might have something in their kitchens to measure that out, but I needed to Google search for 5 milliliters to teaspoons to determine I needed to take "1.014 U.S. teaspoons" of medicine. (I just rounded it down to 1—I guess that was close enough!)

Get the Distance and Drive Time to Your Destination. My sister will be in Destin next month and asked how far that is from Nokomis. I could have fired up Google Maps or MapQuest, but it was faster to do a Google search for Nokomis to Destin to find out it is "7 hr 14 min (501.1 mi) via I-75 N and I-10 W." (Because I had already configured Google Maps with the word "home," I could even save a few keystrokes by searching instead for home to Destin.)

Get the Current Time Anywhere. Need to talk with your brother who lives in Hawaii but you can't remember the time difference. It's 11:15 a.m. in Nokomis, but you might want to wait a bit to phone him after doing a Google search for <u>time in Honolulu</u>. (It's 6:15 a.m. there.) Shoot! Has the sun even come up yet in Honolulu? Nope. A <u>sunrise in Honolulu</u> search says it won't be up for another 27 minutes (at 6:42 a.m.).




