

#### LET'S CHANGE THE BLE SPEED LIMIT

Maybe when you first saw the headline of this article and thought to yourself, "Is he nuts? If we increase the speed limit here we're going to get somebody **killed!**"

Now that you better understand my perspective, maybe you're thinking to yourself, "Is he nuts? We can't get some of these idiots to slow down to 15. How does he think we're going to get them to slow down to even less than that?!"

You could have a point there. But if you'll sign my "Drop It to 12" petition to submit to ELS, I'll share a few compliance ideas I've been working on that just might help.

In the meantime consider this. On the interstate "everybody" figures they can get away with an extra 5 mph, so the "real" speed limit in a 65 mph zone is 70. Could the "real" speed limit in a 12 mph zone be 17? Or maybe even 15?

#### Women's Voices

I have a long time client who is trying new hearing aids. We'll call him Bob. Bob has worn hearing aids for years and his lifestyle is very active. He is involved with a few groups in town, regularly attends HOA events and connects with his family frequently. His level of activity is what I define as a demanding lifestyle for hearing.

To ensure a successful fit, I let him try a variety of manufacturers so he was confident in his hearing. He dropped in during one of his demo phases and Karen was in her office, so he popped his head in and said "hi" to her. He made a slight comment about having challenges hearing women's voices, so Karen wanted to dissect exactly what the challenges were so I could help Bob hear his best.

So, Bob mentions he struggles to hear women's voices in TV and music. Also he struggles when he is sitting in the backseat of a car.

Bob is currently wearing a higher end hearing aid that offers more flexibility to attack specific areas of hearing loss. I was able to adjust three internal settings speech in noise, noise reduction and soft speech. I adjusted each of these settings from the manufacturer default setting to one that was specific for Bob's listening preference.

Bob wore the hearing aids with the new settings for a couple of days and reported back that he did hear better with the new settings that were specific to his loss. He was able to hear his wife with less strain.

If you also struggle to hear women's voices clearly or your grandkids or you haven't heard the birds that migrated this season, call us to have your settings adjusted to your listening preference.

#### A DEVICE FOR THE FRUGAL

fingernail clippers.

I love gadgets. I think I always have. And if they can save money, that's even better.

If your response is "Me, too!" you need to check out the Equadose pill splitter. Yes, that's right, a pill splitter. This thing is precision machined right here in the U.S. from aerospace grade aluminum. On their website (www. equadose.com) they explain in detail the considerable engineering behind this device,

which I find fascinating. In a nutshell its design

is like the difference between trying to cut a pill

with one bladed scissors versus a giant set of

But what really counts is the results, right? With a \$5 drugstore pill splitter or with a kitchen paring knife what you end up with is one half of a pill (if you're lucky) and a pile of pill dust. With the Equadose what you get is two almost identically sized half-pills and virtually no pill dust.

 $The \, Equadose \, has \, two \, potential \, short comings.$ First, while it will indeed split tablets as small across as a pencil eraser, that takes a steady hand, a modicum of coordination, and a bit of practice. (The Equadose actually enables me to split over-the-counter Pepcid tablets into fourths for our Toy Poodle, Buttons.)

The second shortcoming is cost. The Equadose goes for \$35, although shipping is free and it's on sale for \$27.99 as I write this. I can hear some people now. "\$27.99 for a pill splitter. Are you kidding me?!"

ya' just gotta have it, you know?

Besides the coolness factor, though, consider this. After I lost some weight my doctor reduced the dosage of one of my meds from 10 mg to 5 mg. He said to just use up my 10 mg tablets by cutting them in half. And somehow he never changed the 10 mg prescription he wrote for me. And I guess nobody ever mentioned it to my insurance company, so that effectively cut my daily expense in half. And since I'm not sure about the ethics of that-much less the legality—I'll let you know right here I just fabricated that story to make a point and it never really happened, even though it could have.

So if you're interested first check out their website and Youtube videos, then let me know if you want me to do a little demo to show you how it actually works.



- 4 eggs
- 1 cup whipping cream
- 1 teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon white pepper
- pinch nutmeg
- ½ cup diced ham
- ½ cup onion
- ½ cup Swiss cheese
- 1. Preheat oven at 375 degrees.
- 2. Use a deep dish pie crust.
- 3. Sprinkle ½ of cheese, ham and onions into pie crust. Whisk together cream, eggs, salt and pepper in large bowl. Pour mixture into pie shell. Sprinkle with remaining cheese.






