

# UNAUTHORIZED STRANGER HERE? CALL THE COPS!

You've seen the sign at our park entrance that warns salespeople they're not allowed to solicit business here. Regardless, our residents have occasionally been summoned to their front doors with "offers" that range from legitimate-sounding to clearly dodgy.

Depending on the vibe you get from the solicitor, your reaction might be to just close the door in his face after warning him that "We don't allow solicitation here, so get out of the park before I call the cops."

However, the following would be a much better response.

Make a quick mental note of his appearance. Say "No, thank you" and close your door. Watch through a window to see if he is driving a vehicle and make a note of it. Report the incident to

the office if it is during normal business hours; otherwise call 9-1-1, reporting that we have a trespasser and providing all the details you observed.

It is important to call the authorities. A few years ago the sheriff was able to arrest a "solicitor" in our park trying to sell a carful of merchandise that turned out to be stolen. Calling the cops might also thwart a solicitor whose real intent is finding homes to return to later to burglarize.

Again, don't warn the "solicitor" that you're going to call the authorities and give him a reason to flea before the sheriff has a chance to show up and investigate.

Granted, you might be savvy enough and assertive enough to just turn away a clean-cut, smooth-talking stranger who randomly knocks on your door. But what about your neighbors? One of them might be naïve enough to let that


