

HOW TO TAME FACEBOOK

Does Facebook show you the kinds of posts that you want to see? Many users don't know that you have a lot of control over what Facebook shows you. First click on Home to take you to your home page, which includes your News Feed, the constantly updating list of posts from friends, family, brands, websites or celebrities whose pages you follow.

This is what we're talking about – controlling what Facebook shows in your News Feed.

In the left side menu, click on the three dots next to "News Feed." In the drop-down menu, "Top Stories" is probably selected already since it is Facebook's default. Top Stories displays the most popular posts (based on Likes, comment activity, etc.) at the top of your News Feed. The other option, "Most Recent," displays your News Feed with the newest posts from those whose pages you follow showing at the top.

The third drop-down menu choice is "Edit Preferences." It gives you the following options for customizing your News Feed.

Prioritize who to see first. From all the people and pages you follow, you can choose up to 30 to display at the top of your News Feed.

Unfollow people to hide their posts. When you Friend a person you automatically follow them, and their posts are automatically displayed in your News Feed. You can unfollow a person to stop seeing their posts in your News Feed without Unfriending them.

Reconnect with people you unfollowed. This lets you once again start seeing in your News Feed the posts of a person you unfollowed.

Discover Pages that match your interests. This option shows you Facebook pages that Friends follow and lets you choose which, if any, you want to follow, too. Facebook also searches for pages similar to ones you already follow and lets you choose if you want to follow any of them.




