FROM THE PRESIDENT

That’s not a good thing, and it’s a result of the fact that the January minutes are not posted until after they are approved at the February meeting. It’s even worse if you miss the May meeting, because those minutes are not posted until after the October meeting since there are no association meetings during the summer.

That has changed. You can now find out “unofficially” what happened at a meeting just a

few days after the fact.

Go to our website, www.BayLakeEstates.org. Click on the Association News link, and then under the Association Minutes heading click on the 2018 May Preliminary link. You’ll be able to read the May minutes now, although the word “Preliminary” is splashed across each page in large red letters. After the minutes are approved at the October meeting they will be reposted as “Final.”

Was this change worthwhile? Only you can decide that – and I invite you to share your opinion with me and the other board members.

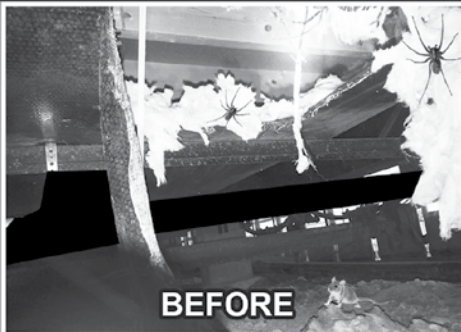

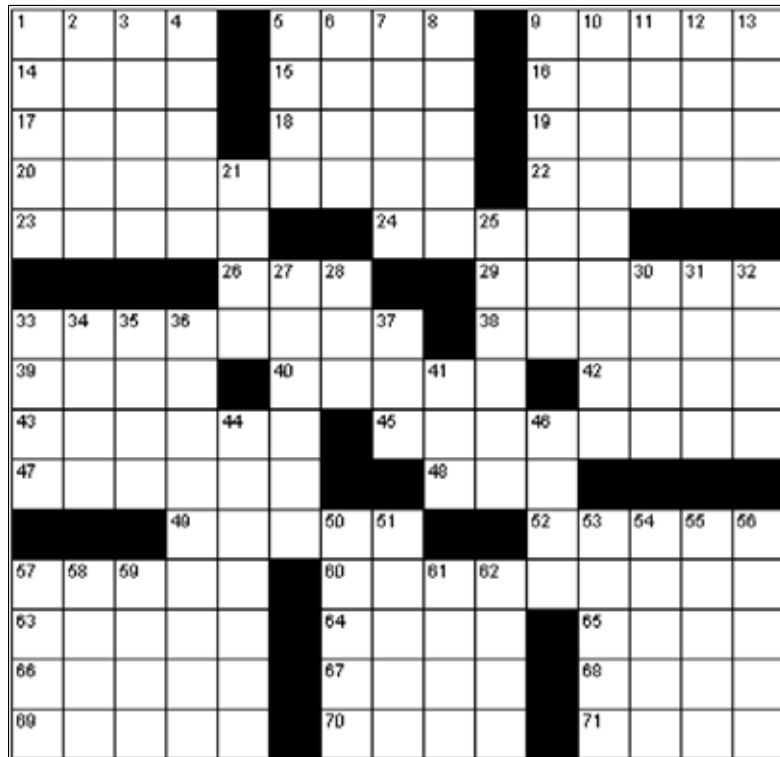

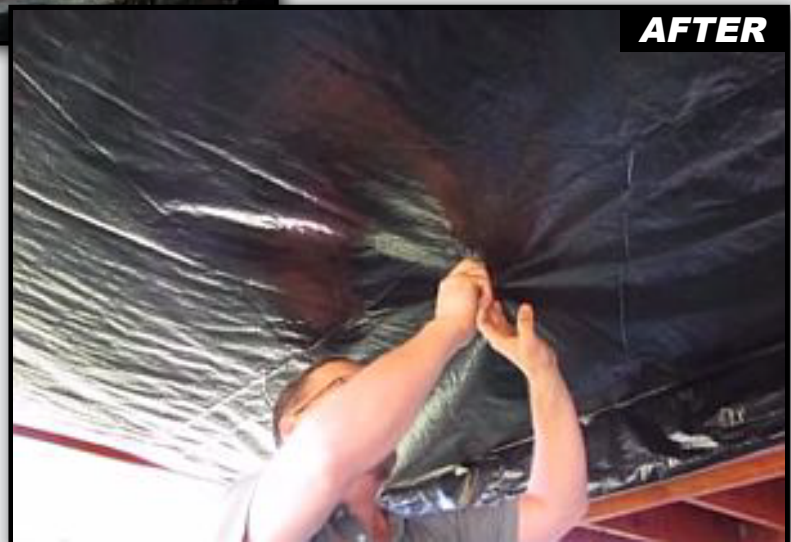
