Studying Swimming

Would you be willing to bet a couple hundred bucks that everything on last year's form is still current? If just one item is out of date, it could easily hurt your wallet way more than a couple hundred bucks.

When you're filling out your departure form, pay particular attention to two areas.

First: Local caretaker's name and phone... and does caretaker have a key?

The Sarasota county sheriff's department actually suggests that seniors should always leave a key with a trusted friend in their neighborhood (mobile home park). You can even "register" the friend's phone number with the 9 1 1 system to assist paramedics with access in a medical emergency. Beyond medical emergencies, if you're out of town the friend you left a key with can help, for example, investigate why there is water flowing out from under your front door! (Yes, that has actually happened.)

The second area of the form to pay particular attention to is "yard care arrangements."

If you let Leslee know you've contracted someone to take care of your weeding and trimming while you'll be away, she will at least have the opportunity to notify you if they drop the ball. Otherwise, she's pretty much stuck with just sending in ELS's contractor and invoicing you (\$50 minimum) for the work.

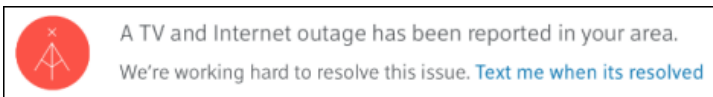

Text Message When Outages are Resolved

Comcast outages can last anywhere from a couple of minutes to a few hours. Our technicians work quickly to make sure that your services are up and running as soon as possible. That being said, we understand that it can be frustrating to wait for services to come back online.

That's why we offer the outage resolution text message feature. Now, you have the option to receive a text message update as soon as your Xfinity services are restored.

1. If you think you're affected by a local outage, log in to the www.Xfinity/support/status
2. If you're experiencing an outage, a notification banner will be displayed on the top of the Status Center and Outage Map.



3. Select **Text me when it's resolved**.

- Enter your cell phone number into the field and select **Get a Text**.

You will then receive a confirmation message that you've successfully requested a text message update when your services are restored.

- **Not in an outage, but still having issues?**
- If you're having Internet issues, try a modem restart.
- If you're having TV issues, try restarting your TV Box.

o **Note:** Double check that all of your connections are tight to the equipment and the wall outlet.

If you receive a call from another company, report it. You will need the name and number of the caller and date and time of the call.) Visit ftc.gov or call 1-877-FTC-HELP. The complaint that you report will be submitted into the Consumer Sentinel Network, which is a database that is used by law enforcement agencies across the world. It helps them to track down the culprits and eventually stop the fraud.

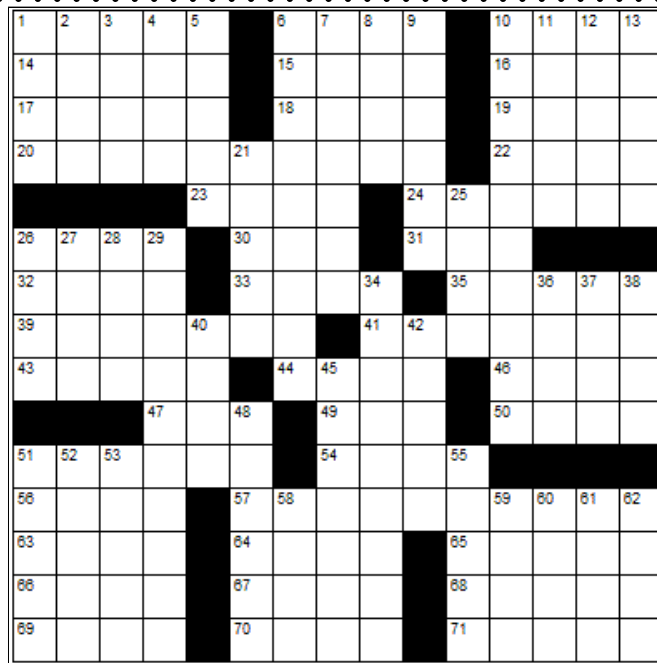
