



WHAT IS TRESPASSING

Some folks inside the park complain that some people, in general, are seen walking between their home, most likely going to the street behind them or to their home via a shortcut. This is not trespassing. We don't own the land our homes sits on.

Merriam Webster defines Trespassing as:

1. a violation of moral or social ethics; an unwarranted infringement.
2. an unlawful act committed on the person, property, or rights of another; especially a wrongful entry on real property.

In Florida, trespassing is defined as **entering** or remaining on private property without permission, which can be proven by clear signage or a verbal order to leave. Penalties vary based on the location and circumstances, ranging from a second-degree misdemeanor for simple trespass to a third-degree felony if the offender is armed with a dangerous weapon or enters certain protected sites. Property owners must provide notice, typically through clearly posted signs, to establish no-trespassing zones.

The reason for this short brief on Trespassing is because of a recent incident in our park where one of our residents was seen inside a home that was about to be demolished. He was caught rummaging through drawers, obviously looking for whatever remnants that may have held some value.

WHERE TO DINE – WHAT TO ORDER

I realize I featured this restaurant in the November issue of the Bay Laker but it is worthy to note, if you are an avid diner in search



of somewhere great to dine for any occasion, of the variety of entree’s this establishment offers that is not on their regular menu. For example, on my 2nd visit to Longet my girlfriend and I both ordered a seafood item from the chalk-board special menu – Hog Snapper (me) and Branzino (her). Hog Snapper is in the Hog Fish family and not the snapper group. A very mild flavored fish and if cooked right the skin was just as enjoyable as the meat inside.

Branzino is the Italian name for the European sea bass, a mild, white fish popular in Mediterranean cuisine that is known for its delicate, flaky, and slightly sweet taste. The serving portions were perfect as was the meal itself.

We also tried the Crab Cake appetizer (off the chalk-board menu) and we both agreed those were the best crab cakes we ever had the pleasure of eating. They were soft, instead of crunchy, and simply melted in your mouth. The French style lemony flavored sauce was made to perfection and delicious.

Without sounding too prejudicial I would rate Longet a 5-star restaurant.




