What is McCarthyism? (definition below)

1. a vociferous campaign against alleged communists in the US government and other institutions carried out under Senator Joseph McCarthy in the period 1950–54. Many of the accused were blacklisted or lost their jobs, although most did not in fact belong to the Communist Party.

- o a campaign or practice that endorses the use of unfair allegations and investigations.

*Editor's note: Unbeknown to most folks, simply because this took place long ago, there were some very scary moments in America when Joseph McCarthy ran the roost with no government interference. He did what he wanted, when he wanted and to whomever he decided to target, especially those who worked in Hollywood.*

The following is one true story based on memoirs of Elaine Clark, a resident of Berkeley, CA:

"It was in the spring of 1952 and one particular Sunday, during a Unitarian church service I attended, a group of scary looking men marched inside the church and took over our service. Using the microphone they made a startling announcement to the packed church. They asked if there were any known communists in our church and then proceeded to tell folks that they must pledge allegiance to America or they will be labelled a communist or perhaps be arrested.

Everyone stood up and placed their hand over their heart and repeated the Pledge of Allegiance."

*Editor's note: The following historical true story is what McCarthyism did to one of Hollywood's most prolific writers. This bizarre movement not only ruined lives and careers, it destroyed families, marriages the financial well-being of individuals and wreaked havoc in our society. continued on page 4*

Dalton Trumbo (1905–1976) is the most prominent screenwriter blacklisted from Hollywood. As a member of the "Hollywood Ten," he was **jailed** for refusing to testify about his political affiliations and worked under pseudonyms (e.g., winning Oscars for Roman Holiday and The Brave One) before breaking the blacklist in 1960.

Key details:

- Famous Work: Trumbo wrote famous scripts under fake names or through "fronts" during his blacklisting, including Roman Holiday (1953).
- Breaking the List: He received public credit in 1960 for the films Spartacus and Exodus, marking a major end to the blacklist.
- Other Blacklisted Writers: Other members of the Hollywood 10 included Alvah Bessie, Lester Cole, and Albert Maltz.

*Editor's note: It was a dark time in America whereas our constitutional rights were stripped because of twisted ideals from one man who felt it was important to weed out communism using underhanded tactics he created in his own twisted mind.*

# **SCAM WARNING**

Do you sometimes feel that you are being targeted by scammers who are trying to trick you into sending them money?

Here's some distressing news. If you're part of the over-age-60 group, you are being targeted. While research shows that younger people are more likely to fall victim to scams, older people tend to lose a lot more money when they are scammed – nearly \$5 billion in one recent year. "They often have more money" is the primary reason older adults are frequently targeted; however, there are other reasons as well.

- **Trust and Politeness**

Many older adults were taught as children to treat strangers with courtesy and respect. Scammers take advantage of that trust and politeness by applying pressure as a fake bank employee, computer support technician, or even a grandchild in trouble.

These scams often appear to be a helpful favor or a heartfelt plea, which makes them much more challenging to spot.

- **Changing Technologies**

The pace of technology can be overwhelming! While many older adults use smartphones, social media, and online banking, they may not always be familiar with the latest threats, such as new online scams and AI voice scams.

Scammers today use sophisticated tools that look legitimate: fake login pages, spoofed caller IDs, and even deepfake audio. Spotting scam messages and calls is now harder for everyone.

- **Isolation**

Scammers thrive on their victims' silence. Social isolation, a situation that affects many older adults, often increases a scammer's ability to take advantage of an older adult...and when seniors are scammed they often feel too ashamed to tell anyone. If there's no one to talk to about a strange phone call or suspicious email, it's easier for a scam to succeed.

Scammers will often discourage victims from

talking to others. For example, romance scams frequently involve months of online messaging, during which the scammer slowly builds trust until they ask for money.

- The first thing you must do to avoid the scam
- Further steps to avoid being victimized
- Scammers are very skilled and devious. What to do if despite your best efforts you are scammed anyway.

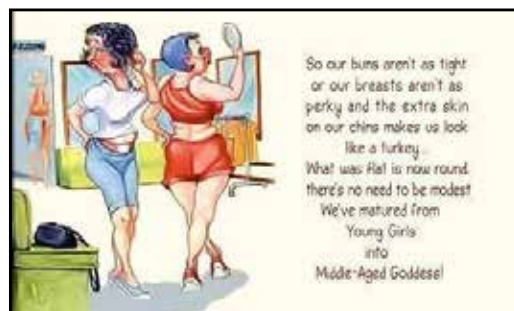

## GOING AWAY? (According to FPL)

### What's the right setting for your A/C?

According to FPL, when leaving for an extended period of time it's time adjust your AC to save money. Their energy expert shares information to help you.

The best temperature setting while you're away is...

Should you turn your A/C off while you're gone? No—but setting it too low wastes energy and setting it too high can create humidity problems. The ideal setting depends on how long you'll be away:

- **Short trips (a few days):** Set your thermostat to **80°F** to reduce strain while preventing excess heat buildup.
- **Longer vacations (weeks):** Set it to **82°F** to balance efficiency and home protection.
- **Seasonal residents:** If leaving for months, keep the A/C set around **78–82°F** and consider using a dehumidifier or a smart thermostat for remote adjustments.

**Pro tip:** Close blinds and curtains to block out direct sunlight and help maintain a stable indoor temperature.

### WALT’S FISH MARKET RESTAURANT & TIKI BAR - Sarasota

**FYI: The Wallin family has been fishing the bays and bayous of Sarasota and selling their fresh catches for over 100 years.**

Rarely do I ever go to Sarasota to dine, simply because we have so many great restaurants close to BLE but my daughter and her hubby were here for a week and they insisted on going to Walt’s for dinner their last night here (Monday).

Well, for starters, I will never go there again during the peak season around supper time – about 1.5 hour wait time to get a table, although certain appetizers are available at the bar you can munch on while waiting.

My daughter ordered the oysters on the half shell which were perfectly small for her and they were shucked down to the shell so there was no need to scrape them with a fork – you can simply put whatever topping you desire like cocktail sauce, horseradish, hot sauce and slurp them down. I tried one oyster and they were very tasty.

I ordered the grouper tacos, blackened, and the meat was so very moist and tender I would order them again. Accompanied by their yummy Island rice this meal was perfectly paired.

Overall, Walt’s is a very popular place to dine in Sarasota and the food is great.
